### **Establishing Patterns of Holy Living**

#### **1. Maintaining *BIBILICAL* standards**

##### **1 Peter 1:15 New King James Version (NKJV)**

**15** but as He who called you *is* holy, you also be holy in all *your* conduct,

##### **Leviticus 11:44 New King James Version (NKJV)**

**44** For I *am* the LORD your God. You shall therefore consecrate yourselves, and you shall be holy; for I *am* holy. Neither shall you defile yourselves with any creeping thing that creeps on the earth.

##### **Romans 5:8-9 New King James Version (NKJV)**

**8** But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. **9** Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

##### **Romans 8:1 New King James Version (NKJV)**

###### ***Free from Indwelling Sin***

**8** *There is* therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

##### **Galatians 3:2-3 New King James Version (NKJV)**

**2** This only I want to learn from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? **3** Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now being made perfect by the flesh?

##### **1 John 1:7 New King James Version (NKJV)**

**7** But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

##### **Romans 12:1-2 New King James Version (NKJV)**

###### ***Living Sacrifices to God***

**12** I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service. <sup>2</sup> And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
